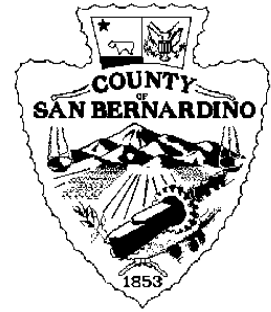

## Supervisor Biane Hosts Annual Holiday Open House

**RANCHO CUCAMONGA** – San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane will host an open house at his district office in Rancho Cucamonga from 5 to 8 p.m. on Thursday, Dec. 17 to celebrate the holidays and to collect gift donations for local military families and American troops serving in Iraq and Afghanistan.

Biane is coordinating his annual holiday open house with State Senator Bob Dutton and Assemblyman Bill Emmerson. In 2005, the three elected officials began hosting their holiday open houses on the same day to make it easier for residents to visit all three offices, which are located in the same vicinity of Rancho Cucamonga.

Biane and Dutton's offices will be collecting "comfort items" such as new books, CDs, DVDs, hand warmers, and hygiene products that can be sent to U.S. troops serving in Iraq and Afghanistan. Visitors can also donate gift cards, phone cards, or new, unwrapped toys that can be given to the families of local military personnel stationed overseas during the holidays.

Dutton's office will also be collecting canned and non-perishable food for the GAP Food Bank. Emmerson's office will be collecting new, unwrapped toys for the U.S. Marine Corps Toys for Tots program.

"Our open house event is a great way for people get into the Christmas spirit, and it's something I look forward to every year," Biane said. "We collect boxes and boxes of gifts for great causes, and I also get a chance to personally meet and speak with residents from throughout the Second District."

Supervisor Biane's office is located on the southeast corner of Haven Avenue and Arrow Boulevard. Assemblyman Emmerson's district office is located at 10681 Foothill Blvd., Suite 325, and Senator Dutton's district office is located at 8577 Haven Ave., Suite 210.
