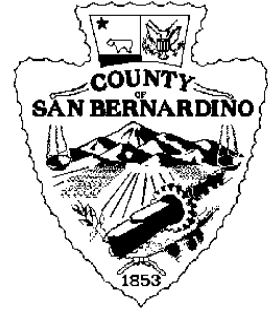

Board Approves No-Parking Zone on Cherry Avenue

FONTANA –A no-parking zone on Cherry Avenue that was approved by the Board of Supervisors on Tuesday will improve traffic safety in unincorporated Fontana by making it safer for commercial truck drivers to exit a local commercial truck dealership.

A representative from Kenworth Trucking contacted the County and reported that vehicles parked on Cherry Avenue near San Bernardino Avenue were blocking the view of truck drivers exiting the business. County Public Works officials investigated and determined a no-parking area was warranted on southbound Cherry Avenue south of San Bernardino Avenue.

“This is another great example of how residents and business owners can help improve safety on County roads by reporting their concerns to my office or the Department of Public Works,” San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane said.
