Forget *WordArt!* Learn new styles of lettering that you can use to express yourself! Make colorful and three-dimensional writing that will take your art to a whole new level! Explore the history of lettering graphics from early times to the present.

Local artist Joey Novotny will teach participants several styles of lettering at two different workshops. Novotny has participated in “Express Yourself” in art at the museum, and he will bring samples and photos of his artwork, including his custom detailed model trains and room murals.

On June 26, Joey will focus on personal styles – lettering for the fun of it! Participants will take home “alphabets” of the different styles covered in the workshop. Additionally, each person will design and create a colorful, one-of-a-kind nameplate.



On July 17, Joey will introduce several styles of lettering and talk about how graphic artists make money doing something they love. Learn how to use pens, markers, and paints to achieve different effects. Each participant will have fun creating a business sign or personal logo.

You may sign up for either workshop or you can take both! These workshops are designed for ages 12 and up, with no previous art experience required. There is no separate charge for these workshops; they are included with your paid museum admission (admission is free for Museum Association members). Pre-registration is strongly recommended!
