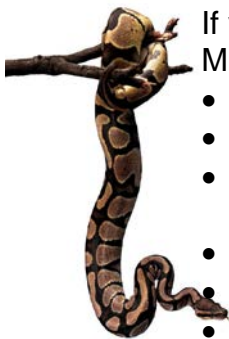

- Some fees apply to some activities.

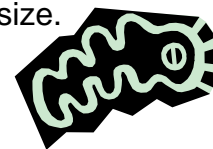

PETROGLYPHS AND PICTOGRAPHS!



Find out how Native Americans created rock art and then try it out yourself! When you are making a petroglyph, you carve into the rock. When you make a pictograph, you paint on the rock. In these family workshops, you will get to try out both techniques using authentic Indian symbols in your art. Workshops start on the hour (11:00 a.m., 12:00 noon, 1:00, 2:00, 3:00, and 4:00 p.m.) and are limited in size. The cost of each workshop is \$1.00 per person with paid Museum admission and tickets will be available at the Museum's front desk at 9:00 a.m. that day.
